- Preparation and e-filing of Federal and Illinois income tax returns
- Preparation of prior-year tax returns (for 3 previous years, some restrictions apply)
- Preparation of amended returns (some restrictions apply)

Please note: The tax site operates on a first-come, first-served basis. The site will stop taking new clients at least one hour before the official closing time and much earlier than that during busy sessions, so please arrive early.
