Also, find out how a Low-Income Tax Clinic (LITC) can assist you with tax matters. No appointment is necessary.

TAS's Problem Solving Day event will be held at the Delaware Low Income Tax Clinic, 600 S. Harrison St., Wilmington, DE 19805 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The Delaware Local Taxpayer Advocate and staff members will be onsite to assist taxpayers who haven't been able to resolve their tax issues with the IRS. Representatives will need to have a valid Power of Attorney (POA) on file with the IRS or can bring their client's signed Form 2848 or 8821. TAS may still be able to assist with general information or questions if a valid POA is not on file or presented.

The Taxpayer Advocate Service is an *independent* organization within the Internal Revenue Service. TAS helps taxpayers resolve tax problems, recommends changes to prevent future tax problems, and protects taxpayer rights. TAS's *services are free* to taxpayers who are:

- Experiencing a financial hardship or having financial difficulties because of a tax problem;
- Trying, but haven't been able to resolve an IRS tax problem; or
- Believing an IRS system or procedure isn't working.
